# Marvellous Me



We've had a wonderful week learning the story of *The Three Little Pigs*. We drew wanted posters to make sure everyone knew what the wolf looked like in case he turned up in class! We've had a great time meeting Numberblock one, two and three. Learning how to explain what makes an amount one, two or three.

Next week will be continuing to look at the traditional tale *The Three Little Pigs*. Some of the learning will include:

- Learning the phonemes h, b, f, ff
- Ordering the story of *The Three Little Pigs* and drawing the ending
- Looking at the composition of numbers 1-4 e.g. smaller groups we can see within a given number  $4 = 2 + 2$  or  $3 + 1$
- Collaging the three pigs' houses
- Learning about the natural artist Andy Goldsworthy and creating our own natural artwork
- Looking at maps of the school and Rickmansworth
- Reading stories that have maps in them

Please use these to practise the letters and to begin to support your child to read 3 letter words e.g. cat, dog, sit, pit, pan, pat, sat, mat, mad, pad etc. If your child is starting to read these simple words, please write in the reading record as they will be ready for reading books.
