





<p>Phoneme</p> <p>The smallest unit of sound in a word. The word hat has 3 phonemes.</p>  <p>/h/ /a/ /t/</p>	<p>Grapheme</p> <p>The letters in a word that represents the sound</p> 
<p>Trigraph</p> <p>A combination of 3 letters representing one sound</p> 	<p>Blending</p> <p>The act of smoothly joining together sounds to read a word</p> 
<p>Digraph</p> <p>A combination of 2 letters representing one sound</p> 	<p>Segmenting</p> <p>The act of breaking up a word into individual sounds</p>  <p>/d/ /o/ /g/</p>
